

Westside Purple Line Extension Section 3 Project

As many of you know, there is (and will continue to be) some major construction work in the area related to the new Purple Line subway extension.


According to the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA), the 8.9 mile Westside Purple Line Extension begins at the future Century City Station. This section runs entirely underground, primarily following Wilshire Boulevard, with stops near UCLA and the Veterans Hospital. Currently, the plan is to open for service in 2026.

Hours of operation will be:

Sunday-Thursday (5:00am-12:00am)

Friday and Saturday (5:00am-2:00 am)

Wilshire BI between Veteran Av and Westwood BI: LADWP Coordination Work

Wilshire BI between Veteran Av and Westwood BI.

Date: Ongoing through Summer 2023

Work hours: Monday to Friday, 11pm to 6am and 9pm to 6am

Traffic Control:

Phase 1: 11:00 pm to 6:00 am

- Three eastbound Wilshire BI lanes will be closed between Westwood BI and Gayley Av. Lane reductions begin just west of Veteran Av.
- Left turns will be restricted for eastbound Wilshire BI traffic to Gayley Av.
- The west leg crosswalk will be closed.

Phase 2: 11pm to 6am

- Three eastbound Wilshire BI lanes will be closed between Westwood BI and Gayley Av. Lane reductions begin just west of Veteran Av.
- Left turns for Wilshire BI at Gayley Av will be closed.
- The east leg crosswalk will be closed.


Phase 3: 9pm to 6am

- Two westbound Wilshire BI lanes will be closed between Glendon Av and Gayley Av. Lane reductions for westbound Wilshire BI traffic will begin just east of Glendon Av.
- Left turns will be restricted for eastbound Wilshire BI traffic to Westwood BI.
- Eastbound Wilshire BI lanes remain open for through traffic.
- The west leg crosswalk will be closed.

Phase 4: 9pm to 6am

• Two westbound Wilshire BI lanes will be closed between Glendon Av and Veteran Av.
